APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. Approval of December 1st, 2020 Minutes

Motion/Second to approve the December 1st, 2020 Minutes by Ostrowski/Mulrooney. Motion carried unanimously.

PRESENTATIONS

14. December 27th, 2020 Crash Review by the Portage County Sheriff's Office (I39 & Hy 66)

Crash review presented by Deputy T Levandowski.

Initial 4 vehicle crash on I39 Southbound just south of Hwy 66 occurred at 1:34 pm due to weather conditions. Additional southbound traffic spun out into ditch or median with cable barriers as drivers attempted to brake/avoid the initial crash. Blockage and backup on interstate resulted in shutdown of southbound lanes. TIM team and Stevens Point Fire department deployed. Broken arrow on all area tows to remove vehicles from interstate and staged on ramp way. Cable barriers were an infrastructure factor as snow in median would have likely stopped vehicles before they could enter northbound lanes. Deputy called in to have ramp shut down and gate arm activated but UWSP squad assisted with blocking access. Probably helped prevent vehicles from circumnavigating gate. Commissioner suggested submitting request in to DOT for dynamic messaging signs to be installed along that stretch of corridor as road curvature and downhill grade a factor. Metropolitan area of Stevens Point qualifies but need funding and project to tie into.

Future Crash Review: PSCO will present review of December 30th, 2020 Fatal Crash at Cty Tk A and 2nd Ave in Almond once investigation is concluded.

- Wis DOT (Heineck):
 - Hwy 66/I39 NB off ramp a new signal being installed. Project can start as soon as the snow is gone.
 - Hwy 66 from the SB ramps to the airport will get mill and overlay. Expected to start mid summer.
 - Bus 51 from Springsville Dam to Tommy's Turnpike reconstruct. Expected to start spring time.
- Portage Co Highway Department (Check):
 - Hwy G west of Junction City from Hwy M to Hwy P full reconstruction. Daily lane closure notices. Expect to not be able to travel through the entire section during construction. Expected from June to Labor Day.
 - Hwy DB east of I39 to Cty Tk X will get pulverize and pave. Start after Labor Day to fall.
- Municipal projects:
 - City of Stevens Point (Wiza/Beduhn)
 - North side street reconstruction including 5th Ave and 1st St with smaller adjacent blocks. Expect detours May through most of summer on 1st St from Centerpoint to Portage St due to sewer installation. Project expected to start in May and be completed by Thanksgiving.
 - Business 51 reconstruction project Public meetings Tuesday at 5 pm, Thursday at noon and 5pm
 - Industrial Park resurfacing project. Expected to start after Memorial Day and finish by Labor Day.

- PCSO - Hwy 54 fatal accident. Missing Person reported on Dec 28th. Located by passing driver on Dec 30th down in ditch with trees and snow on top of vehicle. Unable to determine what caused the crash but was traveling eastbound, crossed westbound lane and entered ditch on west side. Alcohol was present in system.

- Crash spot map review for 2020 vs 2019. Crashes down due to fewer vehicles on roadways and fewer miles traveled. Severity of crashes was up. Attributed to reckless driving and higher speeds.
- Drug and alcohol related incidents up.
- County's motorcycle accidents for 2020 were up and may delve into possible factors/trends.
- Work Zone related accidents were 17 in 2020 and 24 in 2019. High compared to similar sized counties.
- Predictive Analytic Hot Spots - 3 in Stevens Point, 2 in Plover.
 - New program to use Predictive Analytics with new DOT project to expand the pilot project started by State Patrol. Will be approached by DOT to participate in project to reduce crashes and receive resources from DOT.

- Legislation back in session.
 - Proposal to reduce age for instructional permit to 15yo.
 - Collection of alcohol-related proposals including Alcohol-to-Go, Curbside pickup and Delivery.
- J Turn at Hy 54 and Cty Tk U/80th St Review:
 - Reduced overall number of crashes and eliminated all injury crashes.

2020 County Spot Map

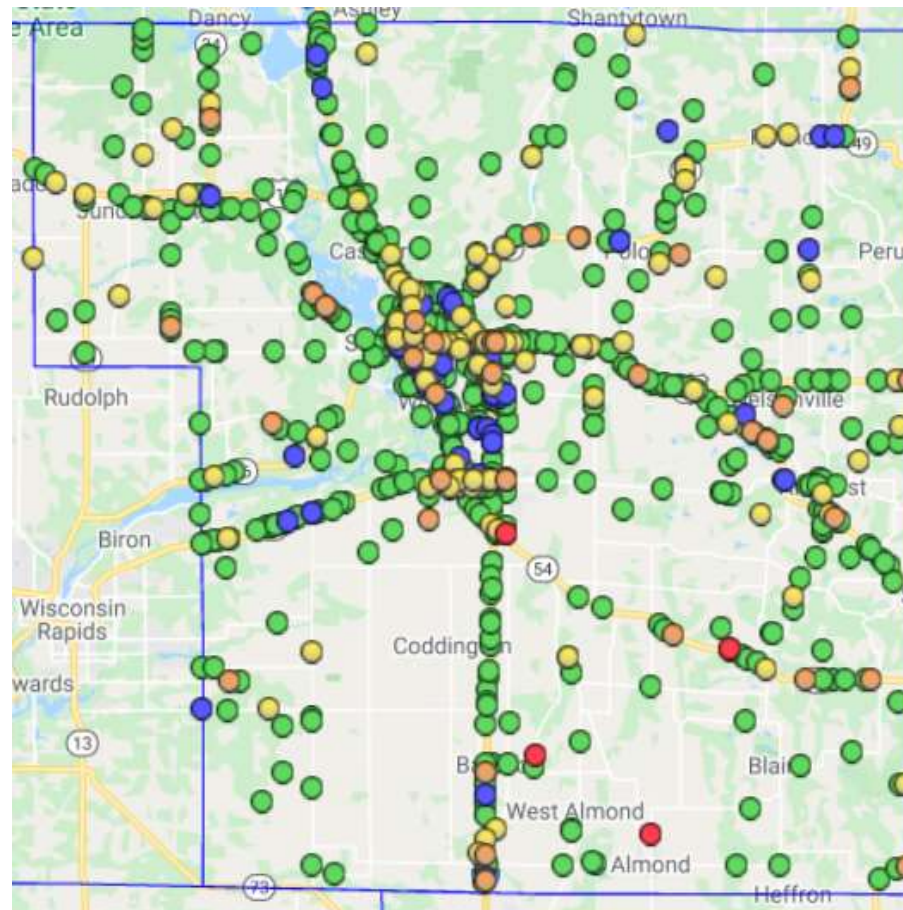

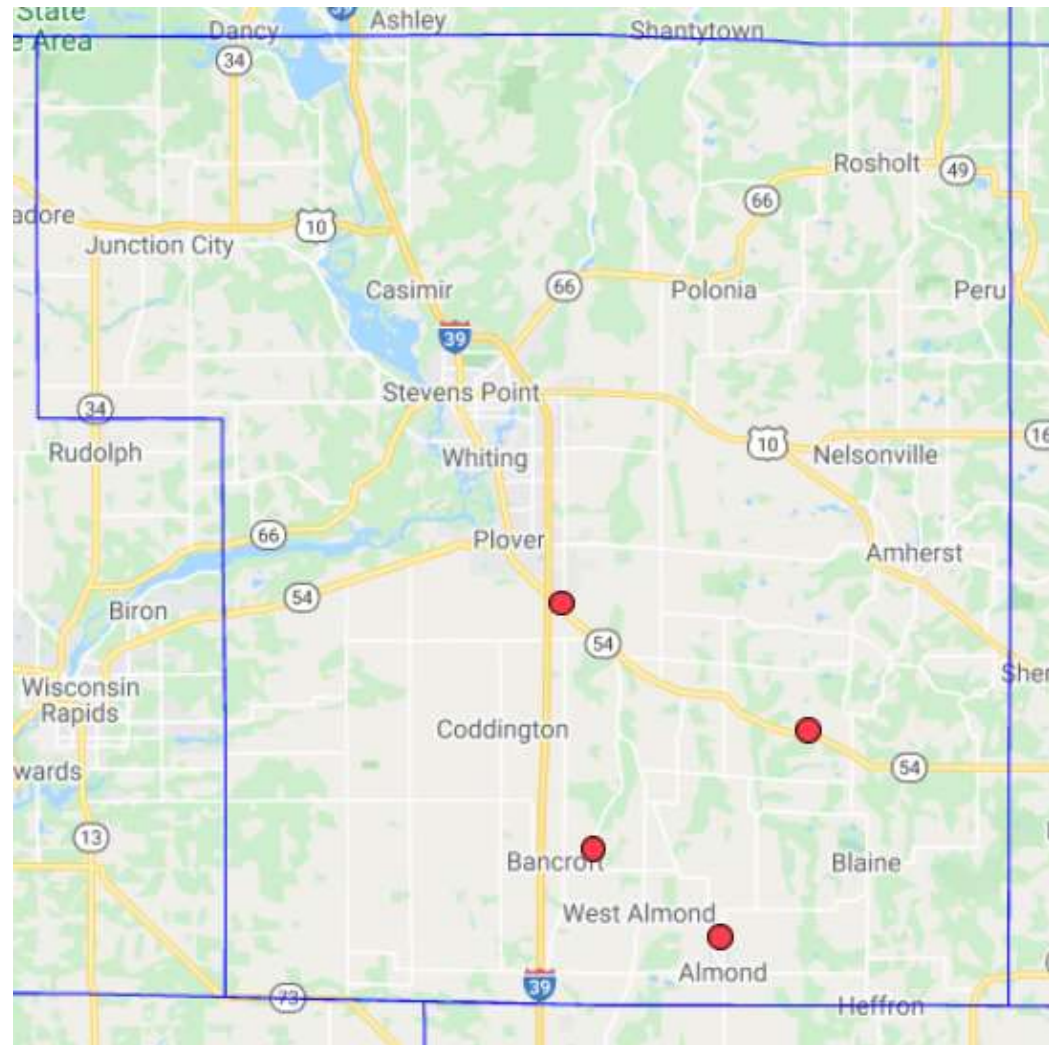

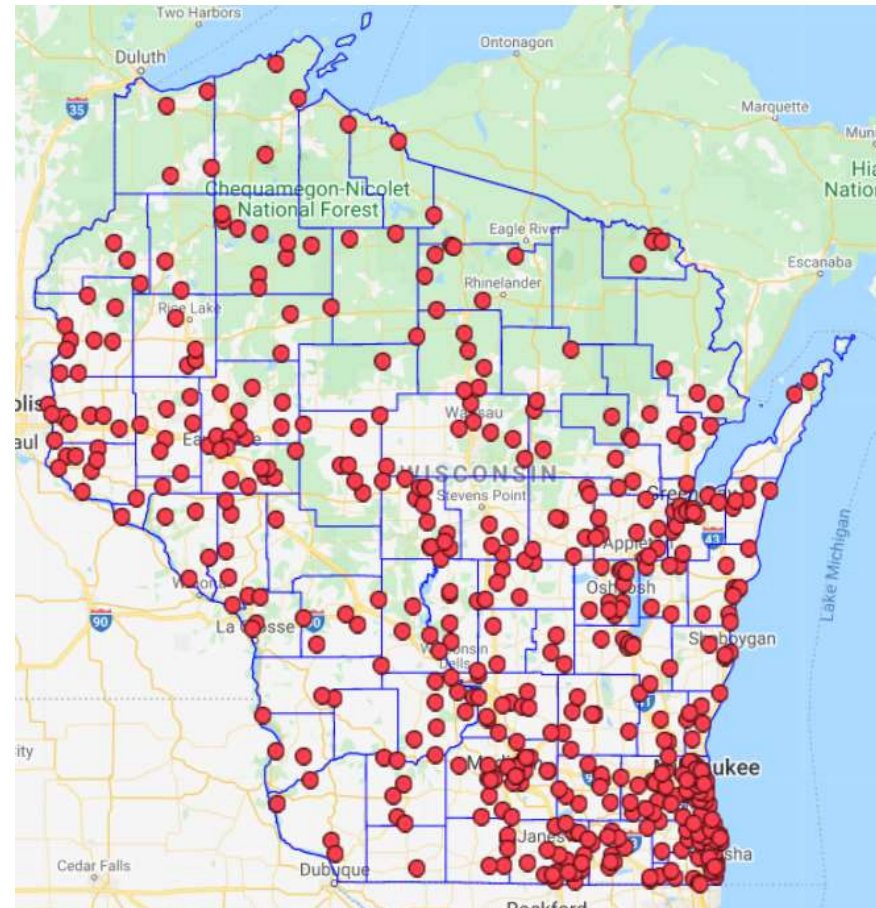

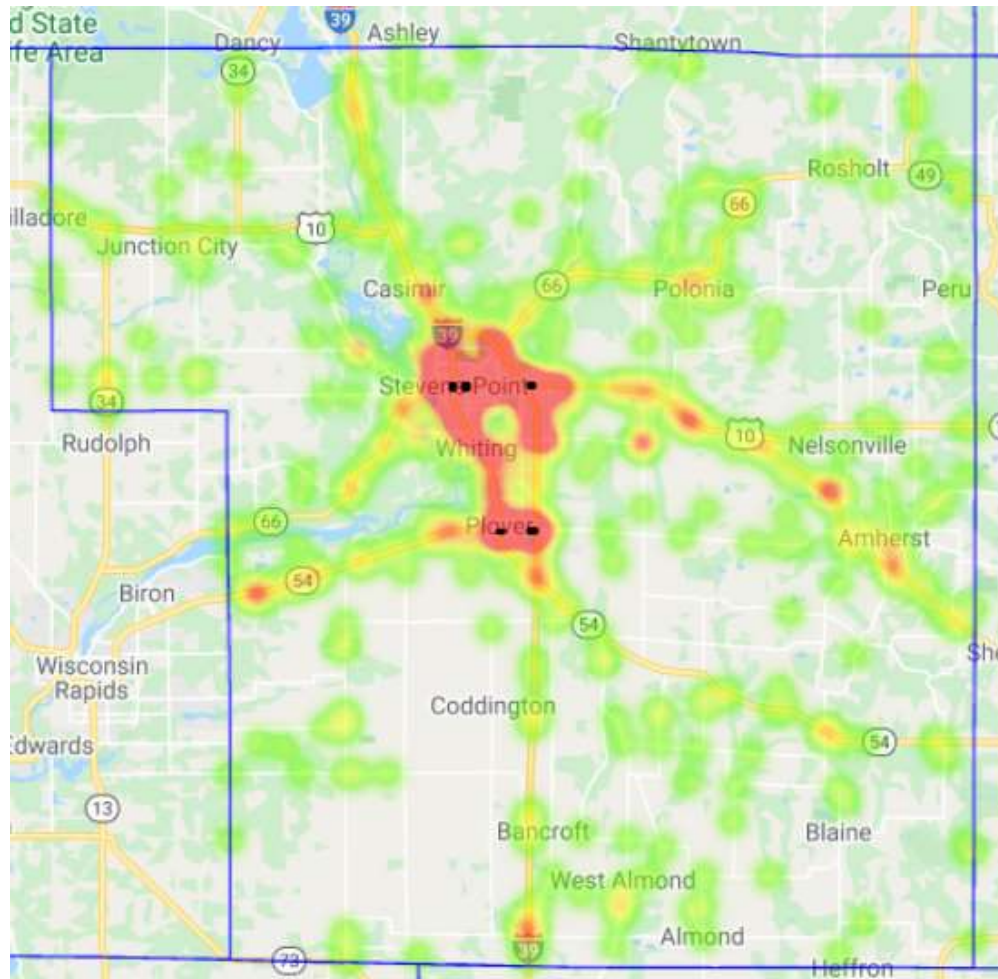

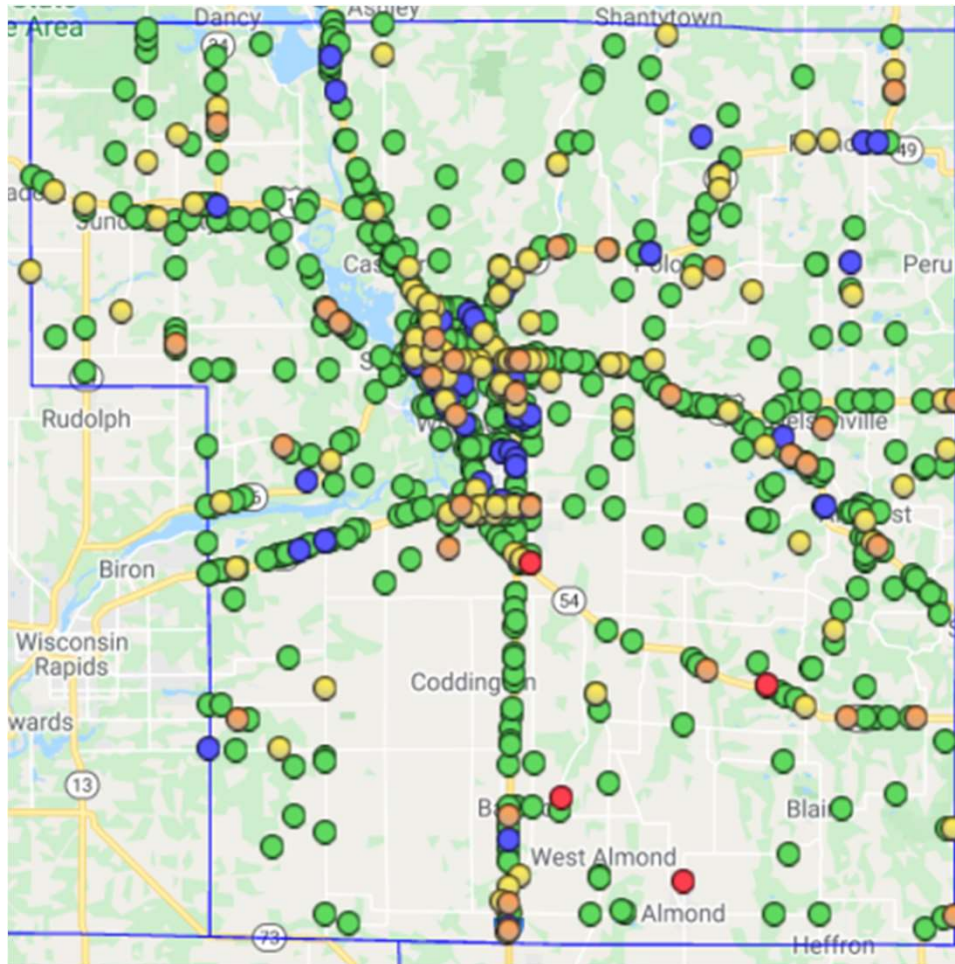
