1. Review of Submitted Minutes from September 14, 2022

Minutes were approved by members present.

2. Discussion of WI State Statute 346.65 (2) (bm) (cm) (dm)

Highlights mentioned were that individuals are not able to repeat the program regardless if they completed the program in a different county. Currently, approximately 25% of individuals in the Post Supervision Program are repeating the program. JusticePoint can send notice to the attorney's that an individual has already completed Post Supervision and is no longer eligible for the program.

Not a large reduction in jail time for 2nd OWI's unless they have a high BAC.

3. Statistics of OWI 2nds in Portage County that Qualify for Post Supervision

Statistics were gathered on how many of the OWI 2nds were within 10 years, was a homicide by intoxicated use of a vehicle, or serious injury by intoxicated use of a vehicle. One person in the last three years met this criteria.

4. Review of Outagamie County SSTOP

Starr reviewed the UW Milwaukee study of the Outagamie SSTOP and how it has reduced OWI's within Outagamie County and reduced jail incarceration.

Starr will contact Outagamie County once again to ask what the incentive is for 2nd OWI's to be in SSTOP.

5. Consideration of Drug OWI Offenses Qualifying for Post Supervision

Drug OWI's are eligible for Pretrial and Post Supervision. Case managers will assess for drug testing frequency as if they were alcohol OWI's. It is encouraged for drug OWI's to be referred.
